Support personnel receive Special Duty Assignment Pay, Civilian Clothing Allowance and have some of the highest promotion rates in the Navy.

All personnel selected for duty at NSWDG must complete a comprehensive screening process which includes a service record review, medical screening, psychological testing and evaluation, PT/swim test, and a formal board.

Eligible Support rates: AE, AG, AM, AT, AW, BM, BU, CE, CM, CTI, CTN, CTR, CTT, DC, EA, EN, EO, EOD, ET, GM, HM, HT, IS, IT, LN, MA, MC, NC, ND, PR, PS, QM, SK, SW, UT, & YN.

Eligibility criteria:

- Volunteer and agree to serve for 4 years
- No NJP, civil convictions or alcohol related incidents for the past 3 years
- No financial problems that will prevent a TS clearance
- Be a U.S. Citizen (no dual-citizenship)
- No medical problems that will prevent PT/Physical Activity
- Qualify as a 2nd class swimmer upon reporting
- Willing to participate in SEAL training evolutions
- Be on call (pager) 24x7 (except leave/off-beeper chit periods)

Our Mission

Naval Special Warfare Development Group (NSWDG) is located in Virginia Beach, VA. NSWDG is a Type 2 Sea Duty CNO Priority 1 Major Command. NSWDG is responsible for the research, development, testing, and evaluation of state-of-the-art, commercially procured and modified equipment in support of Naval Special Warfare operational forces.

Additionally, NSWDG is responsible for the evaluation of advanced maritime, ground and airborne tactics that may be applicable to Naval Special Warfare, and to assist in the determination of the suitability of equipment and tactics for the use by the Department of Defense and the Department of the Navy. Support Directorates include:

Supply/Disbursing

In addition to their regular supply duties, our Supply staff run the warehouse, purchase gear and are accountable for 10,600 line items. Additionally, we control the specialized uniform requirements of the assigned personnel. Our Disbursing Office is responsible for over 1,100 military pay records.

Logistics/Facilities

The Logistics and Facilities Directorates Seabees are responsible for the maintenance of equipment ranging from maritime craft, to specialized SEAL equipment, providing facilities maintenance, and the line-haul of equipment throughout the CONUS.

Combat Systems

Ordnance Division: Maintains, inventories and transports the largest arsenal of ammunition and explosives in Naval Special Warfare. *Weapons Division:* Provides the highest level of reliability, dependability, accuracy and accountability for all weapons systems through aggressive, dedicated engineering and maintenance support programs.

Combat Life Support Systems Division: Responsible for the development of innovative diving and parachute support equipment.

The divers provide supervision of command diving operations, oxygen physiological tech support during military freefall operations and qualify as military freefall parachutists.

Air Ops Division: Leads both military and civilian parachute technology in all aspects of air delivery; they maintain Naval Special Warfare on the cutting-edge of parachuting technology and instruction.

Range Division: Encompasses the largest range complex in Naval Special Warfare.

Administration

The Administrative Directorate is responsible for the overall administration of a command 1,600 strong. Our YNs and PSs are energetic, motivated and are challenged by a “non-routine” work environment. Our personnel possess strong administrative backgrounds and achieve numerous out-of-rate qualifications such as military freefall, static line, and coxswain.

Medical

Special Operations Forces depend on medical personnel to stay operational. Our Medical Directorate provides emergency medicine, sick call, and rehabilitation. Additionally we provide specialty consultations, Wellness Programs, and assist family members with Tri-Care issues.

Communications

If a Naval Special Warfare Operator can't communicate, they can't operate. The Communications Directorate is comprised of IT, ET, MC, CT and Aviation ratings. We test, evaluate, and train on emerging technologies for use throughout the NSW community. Our Sailors possess strong backgrounds in AIS, LAN, WAN, RF, Tech Control, maintenance, radar and communication repair.

Intelligence

In support of RDT&E and implementation of tactics, techniques and procedures the Intelligence Directorate provides timely, comprehensive, and tactically relevant intelligence analysis and production through the entire operational spectrum from initial planning to successful execution. NSWDG is one of the few places you get to see the end results of your analysis and hard work.
